# SIGNS & PANELS

## Mākuā Valley's Cultural and Natural Resources

Cradling approximately 4,200 acres of land in the Wai'anae district, Mākuā Valley includes two ahupua'a (land divisions) - Kahanahāiki and Mākuā - and a distinctive gulch to the south called Ko'iahi. Within this broad, circular valley are many cultural sites and rare native plants and animals, a few of which are highlighted here. Using the panoramic photo of the valley above, see if you can find the location of each of these resources when looking up into the valley!

**Mākuā Valley**

**1 Ukanipō**  
*Ukanipō Complex*  
 There were at least three large heiau (temples) in Mākuā Valley. Ukanipō is the largest and is believed to be the site of the heiau. It is located on the eastern side of the valley.

**2 'Elepaio**  
*'Elepaio (Chrysomitris)*  
 The endangered 'elepaio is a native bird of the Wai'anae Mountains. It is a member of the Trogonidae family and is known for its ability to fly backwards. It is a common sight in the valley.

**3 Kalena Stream Complex**  
 The Kalena Stream Complex is a natural area that includes the Kalena Stream, the Kalena Falls, and the Kalena Falls. It is a popular spot for hiking and fishing.

**4 Ma'o Hau Hele**  
 The Ma'o Hau Hele is a rare native plant that is found only in the Mākuā Valley. It is a member of the Rubiaceae family and is known for its bright yellow flowers.

**5 Kāhuli**  
 The Kāhuli is a rare native snail that is found only in the Mākuā Valley. It is a member of the Helicidae family and is known for its large, spiral shell.

**6 Kuleana Walls**  
 The Kuleana Walls are a series of stone walls that were built by the people of the Mākuā Valley. They were used to mark the boundaries of the ahupua'a and to protect the land from erosion.


**7 Hāhā**  
 The Hāhā is a rare native plant that is found only in the Mākuā Valley. It is a member of the Rubiaceae family and is known for its large, heart-shaped leaves.

**8 Kumuakū'ōpio**  
 The Kumuakū'ōpio is a rare native rock formation that is found only in the Mākuā Valley. It is a member of the igneous rock family and is known for its unique shape.







Areas like Pine Creek Barrens are rare. Prior to settlement, immense prairie-like grasslands covered south-central Kentucky, but most of these natural glades and barrens have been developed or converted into farmland. The 158-acre preserve you are about to explore was slated for development when The Nature Conservancy stepped in to protect it in 1990. It was simply too important to lose. So here you are, standing on a piece of Kentucky's history.

## TRANSFORM

Pine Creek Barrens holds critical habitat for several extremely rare species, including the globally endangered glade cress. How does The Nature Conservancy help these delicate plants thrive? The answer lies in the transformative power of fire.

Throughout history, people have used fire periodically as a land management tool. Fires create and maintain open areas. Certain plant and animal species – including many here at Pine Creek Barrens – depend on these open spaces to survive.

**Managing habitat through fire**

Prescribed burning is critical to the health of Kentucky's prairies, glades, barrens, and woodlands. Fire stimulates flowering and the growth of grasses, while reducing certain woody species. As you hike through Pine Creek Barrens, you'll see where the Conservancy has applied fire to the area. Prescribed burns are planned and conducted by trained individuals under safe weather conditions.


### BASEPLATE MOUNT


### DIRECT EMBEDMENT

Our most popular installation method. Direct Embedment buries the exhibit base directly into the ground with a concrete base, providing lasting durability.




### BASEPLATE COVERS

### SEASONAL MOUNT




